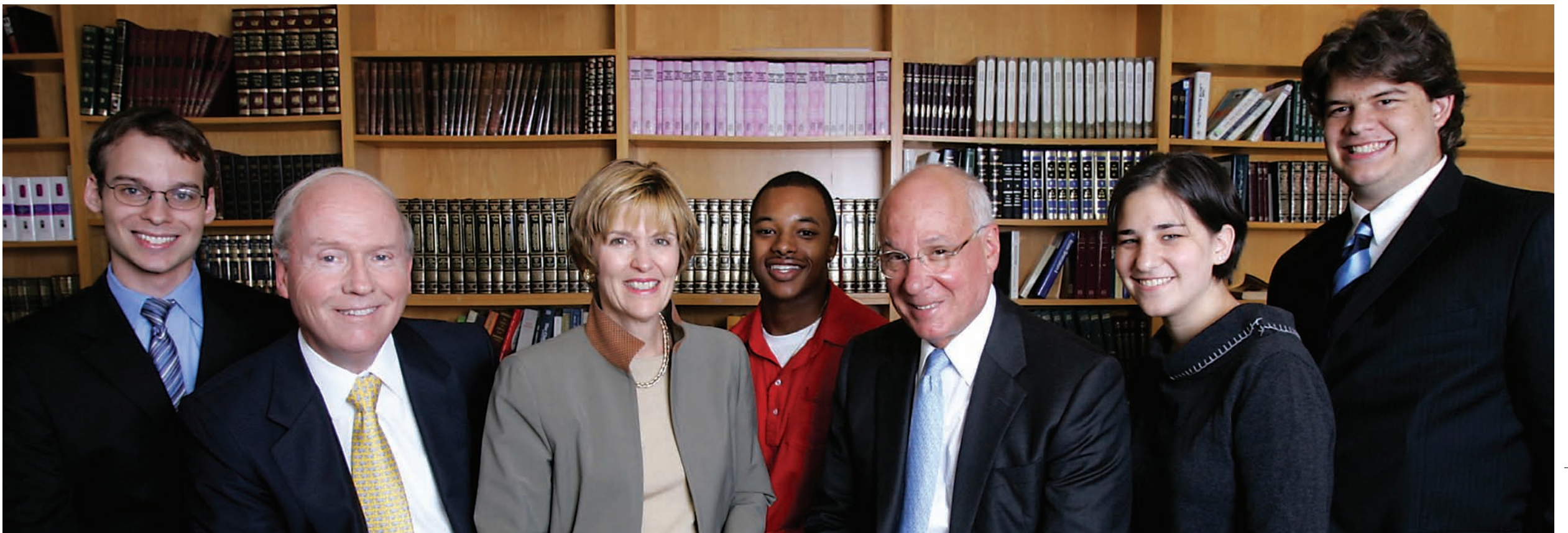


# Thank You, William E. Macaulay
